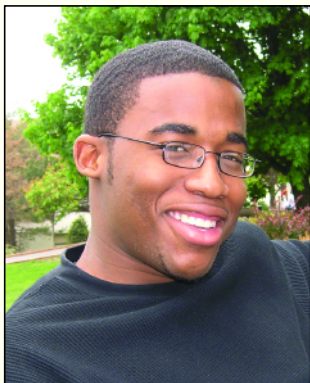


G-UNITY SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT
